LIBRARYSOFT OPACInternet

The OPACInternet Module allows Search access to any computer from across the internet or a network.

Customization is available but first try the system out and see what changes may best fit your library. The link is seamless and no advertising or promotion of third party products are applied.

The main screen displays the name of the Library.

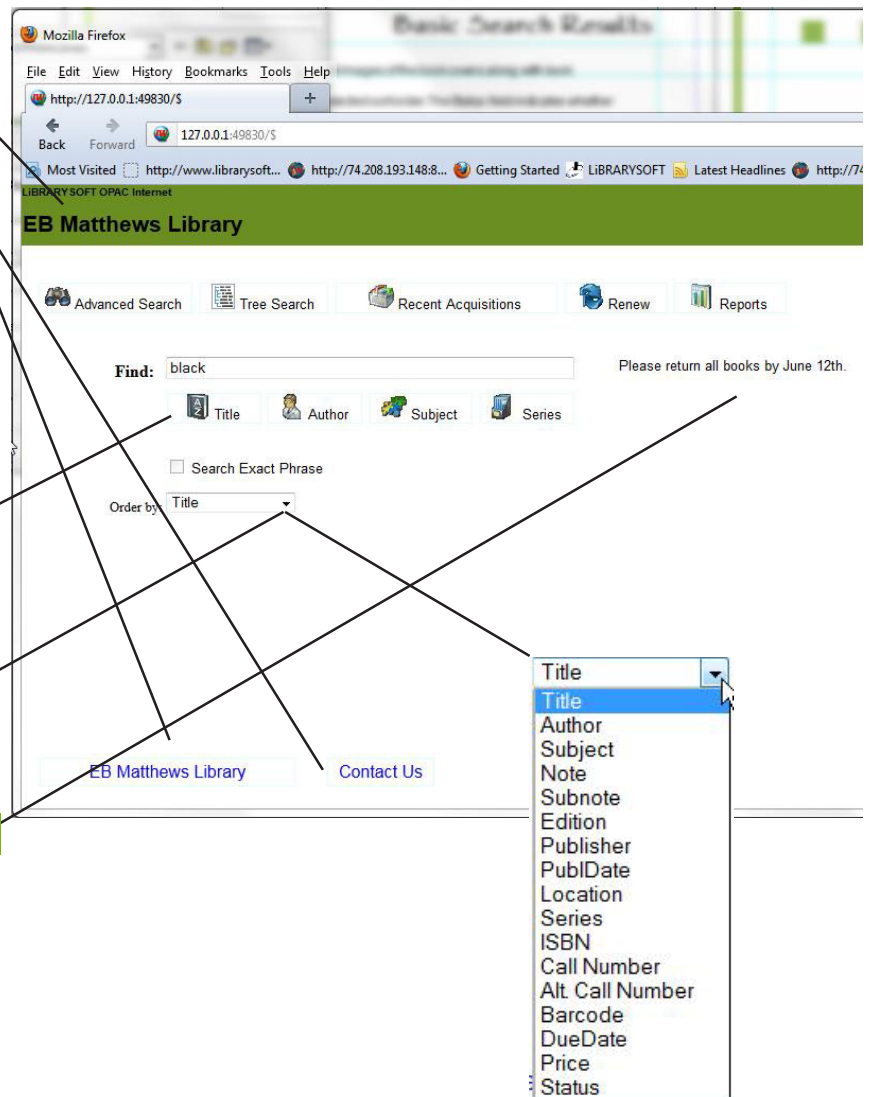
A link to the main library website is available as is a link to Contact access from the library.

One installation does it all as OPACInternet is also a web server. Install it on the server and just point it to your ip address.

In Basic Searching the four most common search fields are displayed for searching.

The search results can be ordered by almost any field using a pulldown.

Notices can be easily displayed on the main screen.

List Results

The Results Screen displays thumbnail images of the book covers along with book

Field information is displayed in the selected sort order. The Status field indicates whether the item is available for borrowing.

The number of pages of results along with total number of results is displayed.

Icons for the other search options are displayed at the top of the screen.

Expansion of the record information is done by clicking on the number beside the record.

Record information

The Record information screen displays general information about an item and provides links for screens with more extensive information. The Library Card screen provides information that would typically be displayed in a library shelf list card. The More Details screen includes download links to pdf and sound files plus the Textstore screen which can hold over 300 pages of text.

Advanced Search

The Advanced Search screen allows layered searches over all fields, sorted in any order.

Extra Subject searching allows searching through extra subject fields that include quality, quantity, comments and multiple video links.

Perfect for technical searches or for those unsure of their search parameters.

Tree Searches

Trees Searches allow patrons to search through a hierarchical subject structure. A general preset structure is included with LIBRARYSOFT and can be modified to best suit your library.

Extra Subjects Search Results

Extra Subjects display not only SubjectS but a quality and quantity value along with associated comments and related videos. There is little value in having a large number of subjects that apply to an item without being able to guage the appropriate relevance to the item itself. Adding video links which could be from regular sites to You Tube videos enhance the user's experience allowing the search result to contribute to the search for information.
